

HANDOVER OF GLOBAL GRANT ON WASH



RC Patan West organized a handover of the Global Grant project on WASH to Shree Shanker Higher Secondary School, Kanchan Rup Nagarpalika, Saptari. The Global Grant with GG No. 2121508 amounts to US\$ 33,017.00. The project includes Water filter system and station installation; Sanitary Pad disposal and Dispenser system installation; School building coloring; Construction of 16 toilets and Urinals for girls & boys, and Training of Teachers (TOT) to teachers of the school. The global grant was conducted with PP Pradeep Man Vaidya as the Primary Contact Person and with the help of RC Sangli Midtown India as an International Partner. Other organizations who helped the project are Kanchan Rup Nagar Palika and the Late Captain Stephen Welfare fund.





HANDOVER OF DENTAL CHAIR AND EQUIPMENT



In a ceremony arranged by the Nagabahal Tole Sudhar Samiti on the occasion of the 2566th birthday of Lord Buddha, Rotarian Surendra Govinda Joshi handed over a dental chair to Mr. Yagya Ratna Dhakhwa, the President of Nagabahal Community Health Clinic. The support is the continuation of biennial support provided by the BaSu trust (established by Rtn. Surendra Govinda Joshi and Ann Badri Laxmi Joshi) through Rotary Club of Yala. On this occasion, on behalf of RC Yala, Ann President Kumud Pradhan also handed over dental equipment worth Rs. 50,000 necessary for the operation of the dental clinic. Prior to the handing over ceremony, Buddha's preaching was recited by a Buddhist Bhikshu in an appreciable community gathering at Nagabahal. During the ceremony Rtn. Surendra Govinda Joshi made a brief introduction of Rotary International and Rotary in Nepal. He also highlighted the importance of Karuna and Maitri (compassion and fellowship - national and international brotherhood) as preached by Buddha. The ceremony was concluded after the inaugural of the Dental Clinic by the Chief Guest Bhikshu in presence of the clinic authorities.

The Receiving Organization, Nagbahal Community Clinic (NCC) is a non-government non-profit local community organization, established about 26 years back with the main objectives to create public awareness against general health, to provide diagnostic, curative and preventive health care services, and to provide free medical support to the poor and needy patients. Since its establishment, the foundation is providing services to the common people of Lalitpur through health care services, at the same time organizing community development activities related to health and free health camps at the community level.

The activities of NCC are funded by donations from individuals, communities, and organizations, and income generated from the clinic at nominal fees. The general assembly elects the Executive Board comprising eleven members, and the members provide their services on an honorary basis. About 10,000 patients visit the clinic annually. The patients, in general, have to pay nominal fees for the services. Some needy and poor patients get subsidies and even free services.
