

The club's service project chair, Rotarian Engineer Guneshwar Mahato, gave a presentation on the benefits of Sayar filters for producing pure drinking water.

The collaborative effort of the Narayangarh Rotary Club and the Spouses Club of RC Narayangarh also saw the completion of a tree planting campaign in the compound of the mother's house, according to Mejakan Pradhan, president of the Spouse Club. One hundred plants were provided courtesy of the District Forest Office in Bhatarpur, and 75 plants were purchased by the Narayangarh Rotary Club, according to coordinator and former program president Rohit Kumar Shrestha. The Rotary Saaune Drinking Water and Irrigation Project was officially launched at Saaune, Devghat Rural Municipality, by Chief Guest District Governor of Rotary International District 3292 Nepal-Bhutan CA Rtn. Jitendra B. Rajbhandary, Past District Governor Rtn. Sanjaya Giri, President of RC Narayangarh Rtn. Nagendra B. Shrestha, and Chairman of Devghat Rural Municipality Mr Water Center 21 Nepal and Rotary Club of Pasco Kenweek, USA District 5080 both provided support for the endeavor.

The project, which was funded by a Rotary Global Grant (GG 2229636) and cost Rs 5.5 million NRS, was created by Service Project Director Er. Rtn. Guneshwor Prasad Mahato to ensure the continuous supply of drinking water for 35 households and benefit 165 people in an underdeveloped village using the one-tap-per-house principle. This will improve health and increase the village's income through sprinkle irrigation from the farming of vegetables, fruits, and cattle.
